Haryana govt to help people get jobs abroad

CHANDIGARH: The Haryana government will help about 700 persons to get employment in countries like Kuwait, Canada and the Middle East by next year.

Haryana Overseas Placement Assistance Society (HOPAS), a state government venture, has already arranged placements for 11 people in Dubai, Labour and Employment Minister A C Chaudhary said here on Wednesday, while signing MoU with Delhi-based Modi Healthcare Placement (MHP).

MHP would provide nursing training for subsequent placement in the USA, which has large demand for nurses.

Modi Educare, part of MHP would provide training in general english, computer and other related fields so that the applicant can be placed in the USA. The annual fee would be Rs 90,000, Chaudhary said, adding 70 per cent of the trainees would be from Haryana and rest from other states.

"The annual salary of a nurse in India was around Rs 80,000 as against Rs 20-30 lakh in the USA, Rs 8-12 lakh in the UK and Rs 4-7 lakh in the Middle East. The institute has already identified about 700 candidates from across the state, Modi Educare CEO Charu Modi Bhartia said.
