In a bid to tap the maximum job opportunity in the field, the Modi Enterprises has set up Modi Innovative Education Society (MIES) in collaboration with International University of Health Sciences-

(IUHS) which offers an 18 to 20 month advanced courses. The courses are modelled on the American Nursing curriculum and it is designed to include training for CGFNS, NCLEX, TOEFL, TSE and IELTS, she said.
